TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. The applicant must be resident of Bodoland Territorial Region.
2. The minimum age limit is 25 years for General category and 5 years relaxation for S.C. and S.T. category students as on as on 1st July, 2023.
3. The Minimum Educational Qualification of prospective student is 10+2 pass outs from any stream.
4. The selected students will have to sign a bond stating that they shall not discontinue the course.
5. The 1 & ½ year Diploma course includes 6 (Six) months mandatory industrial training at various 5-star category hotels across the nations such as Taj, Oberoi, Leela, Holiday Inn etc. and the training placement shall be facilitated by the Institute.
