Badminton -Tournament Regulations

The tournament will be played in accordance with

- · Laws of Badminton
- Instructions to Technical Officials
- Major Events Tournament Regulations
- Games tournament regulations
- General competition regulations
- Code of Ethics
- Players' code of conduct
- · Coaches and Educators code of conduct

Competitions shall be held for

- Team championships Men
- Team championship Women
- Individual championship for
 - o Men Singles,
 - o Women Singles,
 - Men Doubles,
 - o Women Doubles
 - Mixed Doubles.

Team championship

- Each team shall consist of a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 10 players.
- Team Championship will be contested by 6 teams and shall include the five zonal winners and host state. The championship shall be played initially in groups, followed by a knockout final.
- In Team Championship the six teams shall play in two groups of three, where all teams in each group play each other. A final overall ranking order for each group shall be achieved and the top ranked team in each group qualify to play the finals to decide the Gold and Silver Medals. The second ranked team in both groups will be awarded bronze medal.

- The draw to allocate teams to the groups shall be conducted by lot for the Group Play off. The draw shall be held during the Managers meeting to be held at 5pm on October 18, 2023.
- Each tie shall be decided by the results in order of: First Singles Second Singles • First Doubles • Third Singles and • Second Doubles.
- In group play, all five matches of each tie shall be played and in non-group play, the tie shall be stopped when the tie is decided.
- No player shall play in more than one singles, and one doubles match in a tie.
- Each competing Member is responsible for determining the criteria and method of selecting players for nomination, and for nominating players, to represent the Member.
- Each manager shall hand over to the Referee at the Manages meeting 5
 Singles and 4 doubles pairs in order of strength for team championship. The
 composition of the team for a tie shall be selected from those previously
 nominated and be in the order as ranked. The ranking order of any doubles
 pairing not previously listed shall be at the discretion of the Referee. The
 same ranking order shall be valid for all ties in the competition.
- Any change in nomination of players for a tie is acceptable only if received in writing to the Referee at least 2 hrs prior to the commencement of the tie. The referee shall inform such changes to the opponent team at the earliest. (Before one hour)
- A player who withdraws nomination from the singles event of a tie can be nominated in the doubles event of the same tie.
- After the Nomination of the Team List the Referee may sanction a substitute or substitutes for a player who, in the opinion of the Referee, is incapacitated by illness, accident or other unavoidable hindrance.
- No substitution is allowed after the nomination of a team for a tie is submitted.
- A player participating in two matches in a tie is entitled to a minimum interval of 20 minutes between them.
- In a tie a player who retires or withdraws from a match can, however, participate in other matches in any future ties in the team championship.

If a team is unable to complete a match in a tie (e.g. retiring or conceding a
match due to illness, injury or other unavoidable hindrance), the result of
that match shall count as if completed without the conceding side scoring
another point

Individual Championships

- Single events shall consist of a maximum of 16 entries and doubles events a maximum of 8 entries.
- All events shall be played in knock out format.
- The Draws to the individual championship shall be done at the managers meeting to be held at 5 pm on October 21, 2023.

Clothing

- Championship will strictly enforce the Clothing, Equipment, and Advertising Regulations as outlined in the BWF GCR 20 – 24. This includes restrictions of certain colors for shirts, shorts, and skirts to avoid issues with virtual advertising on TV courts, as per GCR 21.7.
- Mandatory that in Team championship all players of a team wear team colors only and to ensure that each player wears the same color and design of shirts and shorts or equivalent articles of clothing throughout a tie.
- The teams confirm their choice of colours at the time of submitting the team nominations.
- Player name and Team name is mandatory on the back of the T Shirt in accordance with the Summary Sheet for GCR 21 & 23 (BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.8).

Badminton Integrity:

 Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament. To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).
