3. While filling in the online application form, the candidates will get the opportunity to indicate/ chose names of 3 (three) districts in order of their preference and the software will automatically select the best option out of the preferences submitted by them.
4. Candidates should be cautious while submitting the online application as once the online application with their choices/ preferences is submitted against a particular Roll Number, they will not be allowed to submit the online application for second time.
5. After submitting the online application, the candidate must keep the printout of the online application form for all future references.
6. Canvassing directly or indirectly will lead to cancellation of candidature.
7. The office will not be responsible for any lapse in submission of online application due to any technical problem at the end of the candidate.
